

TERMS AND REGULATIONS FOR STALL APPLICATIONS:

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: All applicants shall be subject to Stable Area Rules and the Rillito Park Racing Guide, including but not limited to the following:

1. The terms of this agreement shall be for the 2017 meeting of Rillito Park for the conduct of Thoroughbred and Quarter Horse racing beginning February 11, 2017 and ending March 19, 2017.
2. The applicant shall enter and if permitted, race the horses listed herein which have been assigned free stall space by Rillito Park in races for which they are eligible unless the Racing Secretary shall agree otherwise.
3. The rules and regulations of the Arizona Department of Racing (ADOR) and rights of Rillito Park as a private enterprise shall govern the conduct of this meeting and racing programs and to all the owners, trainers, their employees, respective agents and jockeys.
4. Foal certificates must be filed at the Racing Secretary's office upon arrival and must be approved by the Racing Secretary.
5. Rillito Park reserves the right to reject any entry for any reason or not, Rillito Park may refuse admittance to or eject anyone with or without notice and with or without cause.
6. It is understood and agreed that this is not a lease of any space, but is merely a revocable license granted by Rillito Park, only on the terms and conditions set forth. Rillito Park reserves the unrestricted right to decline stall space, reduce the number of stalls allocated, revoke this license at will, for any reason, or no reason, and to require any Applicant using stall space to vacate stalls and move all horses, equipment and personnel off the Rillito Park premises within seven(7) days of receiving notice from Rillito Park.
7. All jockeys, trainers and exercise personnel are required to wear safety helmets and vests while riding or exercising horses according to the requirements of the Arizona Department of Racing (ADOR).
8. All changes in trainers must be reported to the Racing Secretary immediately along with the owner's and previous trainer's authorization.
9. Firearms, fireworks or any explosive materials and/or any other type of weapons are absolutely prohibited on the premises of Rillito Park.
10. No heating or cooking devices are permitted in barn areas (unless supplied by Rillito Park). Heat lamps are not permitted in the barn areas. No flammable liquids or materials are to be stored in the barn area.
11. The use of, distribution and possession of alcoholic beverages is not permitted in the barn area(s).
12. No smoking is permitted in any barn. Smoking shall only be permitted in specified areas.
13. Sawdust or shavings are the only approved bedding in stalls. Applicant and all employees must place sawdust, shavings, manure and trash in respective receptacles and keep such areas in acceptable condition.
14. No dogs are allowed on the premises of Rillito Park
15. All horses (including ponies) entering the premises from out of state are required to have a negative Coggins Test Certificate, dated within the past 12 months.

List of terms continued:

16. All owners, trainers, jockeys and their employees must obtain a license issued by the Arizona Department of Racing (ADOR). This license must be worn or produced on demand by any member of the Arizona Department of Racing, Rillito Park security or officials of Rillito Park.
17. All trainers and /or owners must show proof of current Workers' Compensation policy covering all of their employees including exercise people and list the policy number with security.
18. Horses allotted stalls as part of this Agreement should attempt to arrive between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on date(s) indicated by the Racing Secretary to be able to be given their stalls and taken care of as quickly as possible. **DO NOT SHIP IF STALLS HAVE NOT BEEN CONFIRMED BY RACING SECRETARY**
19. Applicant, their employees and any other individual or allotted barn, stall or and/or vehicle brought onto the grounds of Rillito Park may be subject to search by Rillito Park or its agents.
20. Applicant acknowledges that allocation of stalls by Rillito Park pursuant to this application does not entitle, guarantee or grant any rights to applicant to remain in possession of any allocated stalls whether during the term of the Rillito Park meet or after the end of the Rillito Park meet.
21. Rillito Park reserves the right to start all races with or without a stall gate starting machine.
22. All horses entered at Rillito Park Race Track must be on the grounds no later than 12 PM Saturdays and Sundays, 2 PM Fridays on the day of their race. Horses receiving Lasix (Salix) must be on the grounds at least four (4) hours prior to scheduled race time.
23. Trainers will be held responsible for his/her employees and guests following all barn area rules. Each trainer is responsible for his/her own stall area. Failure to comply with these rules may result in a fine by the Stewards or revocation of stall assignments.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

By stabling and/or racing at Rillito Park, Horsemen agree to fully exonerate, indemnify, defend and save harmless Pima County, Rillito Park and Rillito Park Foundation, its owners, agents and employees from and against all claims, actions, demands, losses and damages arising out of or resulting there from, and all expenses incidental to the defense of any such claims, actions, demands, losses and damages, including costs and attorney's fees, based upon or arising out of damage or injury to the Horsemen or other persons, including disability or death, or damage or injury to the property, including loss of use thereof, caused by or sustained in connection with the activities at Rillito Park in which Horsemen take part.
